- V. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR SENGERNS Departments utilizing 1-passenger vans must enforce the following requirements or utilize alternative forms of transportation:
  - A. Experienced Drivers Drivers of 15passenger vans must be at least the age of 25. No student may drive 15passenger vans, including student athletes.
  - B. Training—All operators of 15passenger vans are required to participate in training arranged by the LU Office of EHS & Risk Management. Training courses will needs to be the detailed well in advance. Any costs will be the sponsibility of the driver's department.
  - C. Tire Inspection Prior to each trip, the tires must be inspected to assure they are properly inflated and not worn. Maintenance, repair, or replacement of tires must be carried out prior to any trip if the inspection shows any issues.
  - D. Cellphones- The van driver shall not use a cellphone while operating a vehicle, including hands free operation.
